9 Millionth Mustang Built

STORY CITY, Iowa, May 6, 2008 – Iowa farmer Thomas Krumm went to his local Ford dealer to order a Mustang GT convertible and unwittingly ordered a piece of history – his Mustang is the 9 millionth built by Ford Motor Company .

He discovers that today when he picks up his milestone Mustang at Gookin Ford in Story City, Iowa.

Krumm, a farmer from rural Story City, became interested in

Mustangs through his daughter, Rachael, a Mustang enthusiast who saved enough money to buy her first Mustang at age 17.

"Having been a Mustang fanatic my entire life, I couldn't be more excited that my dad is receiving the 9 millionth Mustang," said Rachael Krumm, who also is a member of the Iowa National Guard. "I am thrilled that I get to see his Mustang GT and its cool new features before I leave for Iraq."

Mustang sales hit an astounding 419,000 in its first 12 months on the market, and topped the 1 million mark in its first two years, shattering the sales records of any single model in the history of the automobile.

Today, Mustang leads the nearly \$1 billion aftermarket parts and accessories industry as the most personalized vehicle of all time, and has been recognized by SEMA as the most accessory-friendly new vehicle.

Local Ford Dealers Closing Continued

It's been reported the Ford Motor Company is closing more than 100 dealerships around the country. Here at John Nolan, they didn't want to go on camera, but were forthcoming about telling me ... Ford believed there were too many franchises in the Tri-State area ... and so the auto maker offered them some assistance in closing down.

These are tough times for automakers. Ford stock is down about 36 percent this year. GM today was selling at a 33 year low. The sticker on this Ford vehicle kind of says it all it's showing operating costs based on gas at 2.80 a gallon. We all know that's not the pump price. Americans aren't in the mood to buy trucks and s-u-v's ... that have meant big business to Ford in the past ... and they're also increasingly just not in the mood to buy a vehicle

Three percent of the economy is tied to the auto industry. So, economists are alarmed to see American automakers struggling more than they have in decades. With high gas prices, no one expects a quick turn around.

Last year, the big three auto dealers combined closed more than 400 dealerships nationwide. This year, the number is expected to go

Ford alone is looking to cut five billion in operating costs by year's end. John Nolan will sell it's last new car July 20th ... and used cars will be on the lot until they're gone ... that could take a four or five months. This property is now also up for grabs. They're willing to sell or lease the property.
